

CHAPTER 184.

Inspectors to
certify result,
&c.

§ 2. The inspectors of said election shall certify the result thereof, with their proceedings, to the clerk of said trustees, and deliver the certificate thereof to such clerk within twenty-four hours after such election shall have closed.

Repeal.

§ 3. So much of any law as confers judicial power upon the president of the village of Waukesha is hereby repealed.

§ 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 184.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act to incorporate the city of Ripon," approved March 20th, 1858.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Three mills
stricken out
and four mills
inserted.

SECTION 1. Chapter seven of said act is hereby amended by striking out the words "three mills," where they occur in the second proviso in section five of said chapter, and inserting the words "four mills," in place of the words so stricken out.

Ward bounda-
ries.

§ 2. From and after the second Tuesday of April, 1860, all that part of said city of Ripon lying north of the half section line, which runs east and west through the centre of sections twenty and twenty-one in said city, and extended to the eastern boundary thereof, shall constitute the first ward, and all that part of said city lying south of said line shall constitute the second ward: *Provided, however,* That the common council shall have power to change said dividing line.

§ 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
