

CHAPTER 353.

[Published April 28, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend section 39, of chapter 79, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of railroads."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section thirty nine (39), of chapter seven-^{Amendment.}ty-nine (79), of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of railroads," is hereby amended by striking out the words, "to the amount of twenty dollars or more," where they occur in the second and third lines of said section.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 354.

AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-two, of the General Laws of 1859, relative to the sale of lands for unpaid taxes, and the conveyance and redemption thereof.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section four, of chapter twenty-two, of^{Amendment.} the General Laws of 1859, is hereby amended as follows: the word "hereinafter," in the twelfth line of said section four, is hereby stricken out, and the word "hereinbefore," is substituted in its place.

SEC. 2 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
