be transferred by the city by indorsement made there- CHAPTER 106. on by the mayor and clerk; and in case the amount May be transferdue on any such certificate is paid at any time before red. the land or lot therein described is deeded by the county, pursuant to any sale for the non-payment of such taxes, the sum so paid shall be forthwith paid over to [by] the officer receiving the same to the city treaserer, for the benefit of the holder of such certificate."

Section 6. All acts or parts of acts contravening Repeal. either the letter or spirit of this act, are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AN ACT to amend section 1 and to repeal section 3 of chapter 170 of the private and local laws of 1860, entitled "an act to amend chapter 193 of the private and local laws of 1859, entitled 'an act to incorporate the village of Oconto."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 170 of the private Repeal. and local laws of 1860, entitled "an act to amend chapter 193 of the private and local laws of 1859, entitled 'an act to incorporate the village of Oconto,'" is hereby amended by striking out all after [of] said section after the word "west" in the tenth line.

Section 2. Section 3 of said chapter is hereby re-Repeal. pealed.

Section 3. All acts and parts of acts which conflict Repeal. with or contravene the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

This act shall take effect and be in force Section 4. from and after its passage.
