

## CHAPTER 13.

[Published February 7, 1861.]

AN ACT to amend Section 94 of Chapter 13 of the Revised Statutes, entitled "of Counties and County Officers."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

Amendment.

SECTION 1. Section ninety-four of chapter thirteen of the revised statutes of the state of Wisconsin, is hereby amended by striking out the word "two" in the third line of said section and inserting the word "three."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 14.

[Published February 7, 1861.]

AN ACT to authorize the Aldermen and Councilors of the first and seventh wards in the city of Milwaukee, to convey certain Real Estate to the said city.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

Authority to al-

SECTION 1. The aldermen and councilors of the first and seventh wards in the city of Milwaukee, and state of Wisconsin, for the time being, are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to convey by deed of bargain and sale, in due form of law, to the city of Milwaukee aforesaid, for such consideration as may have been, or shall be agreed upon, all the right, title and interest which the said first and seventh wards have in and to lots numbered five and six, in block number fifty-five, as laid out on the map of said city of Milwaukee, published by Increase A. Lapham, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, and being what has heretofore been known and called the "market house" property, situate in the seventh ward aforesaid, together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining.

SECTION 2. A conveyance of the property described in the first section of this act, when duly executed, acknowledged and delivered, shall vest all the right, title and interest of the said first and seventh wards in and to said lots of land, and the building standing thereon, in the city of Milwaukee aforesaid; and it is hereby made the duty of the common council of said city of Milwaukee to cause the deed of said premises to be duly recorded in the office of the register of deeds in Milwaukee county, state of Wisconsin.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 15.

[Published February 9, 1861.]

AN ACT to legalize the Assessment Roll of the Town of Dayton, Waupacca county, Wisconsin, for the year 1860.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. That the assessment roll of the town of Dayton, Waupacca county, state of Wisconsin, for the year 1860, as made out by the clerk of the board of supervisors of said county, and corrected by the town clerk of said town of Dayton, is hereby legalized and declared to be valid.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
