CHAPTER 142.

AN ACT declaring certain portions of the Sheboygan and Fond du Lac Plank Road a Public Highway.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The line of road of the Sheboygan and What portion so Fond du Lac plank road company, including their road bed so far as the same lays within the towns of Forest, Empire and Taycheeda, to the village of Taycheeda, to where the same intersects the Green Bay road, in the county of Fond du Lac, having been abandoned by said company, is hereby declared and established as a public highway, and subject to the control and management of the supervisors of the above named towns respectively in which said road is situated, like other highways.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 143.

AN ACT to authorize the State Prison Commissioner to settle with the United States for the support of United States convicts, and to require him to report annually to the Governor respecting such convicts.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the state prison Semi-annual accommissioner, once every six months, to make out and present for settlement to the proper auditing officer of the United States for this state, a certified account of the amount which shall then be due and unsettled for the support and maintenance of United States convicts in the state prison of this state.

Section 2. Whenever the amount due for the main- when saddted, where to be field

tenance of United States convicts shall be audited and allowed, as provided in section one of this act, it shall be the duty of the commissioner to file with the secretary of state a copy of such account stated, with the amount allowed thereon. The secretary of state shall thereupon draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the amount so allowed, payable to the commissioner out of the state treasury, when the same shall be received from the United States.

Report of convicts.

SECTION 3. It shall be the duty of the commissioner when making his annual report to the governor, to include therein the number of United States convicts in the prison at the date of such report, the whole number therein during the preceding year, the number received and the number discharged during the same time, the amount received from the general government for their support and maintenance, and also the amount that may then be due and unaudited for like purpose.

Section 4. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage and publication.
