AN ACT to amend section 12 [of chapter 3] of chapter 267 of the private and local laws of 1858, entitled "an act to incorporate the city of Stevens Point."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Jurisdiction of police justice.

SECTION 1. Section 12 [of chapter 3] of chapter 267 of the private and local laws of the state of Wisconsin, for the year 1858, entitled "an act to incorporate the city of Sevens Point," is hereby amended by inserting the words "and criminal" after the word "civil," in the second [third] line of said section.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AN ACT to lay out a state road from Kewannee to Green Bay.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Commissioners.

Shall award damages.

SECTION 1. C. H. Cunningham, J. R. Slawson, E. P. Carter, E. Decker and F. S. Ellis are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a state road from Kewaunee, in Kewaunee county, to Green Bay, in Brown county. Said commissioners shall, at the time of laying out said road, award to the owners of land through which the same is laid, such damages as they shall deem just, which damages shall be paid by the several towns in which such lands are situated. SECTION 2. Before entering upon the duties required by this act, the said commissioners shall take and subscribe an oath to perform such duties faithfully and impartially, and shall execute to the people of the
