

## CHAPTER 282.

[Published April 11, 1862.]

AN ACT to provide for the publication of the list of unredeemed lands in the county of Clark, in this state.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The clerk of the board of supervisors of the county of Clark, in this state, is hereby authorized and required to publish the list of all unredeemed lands, together with a notice, as now required by law, of the lands which were sold by the treasurer of the said county of Clark, in the month of May, in the year 1859, for the taxes, interest and charges thereon, accruing in consequence of the non-payment of the taxes assessed thereon, in the year 1858.

List of unredeemed lands for taxes of 1858, to be published.

SECTION 2. The said clerk of the board of *(the)* supervisors, shall make out a list of all such unredeemed lands, together with said notice, and cause the same to be published in some newspaper printed in the said county of Clark, which shall be designated for that purpose by an order of the board of supervisors of the said county of Clark; and the clerk of said board of supervisors shall deliver such notice and list of unredeemed lands to such newspaper designated by said board, *(a sufficient time prior to,)* so that the first publication of said list and notice may be made in said newspaper on or before the fifteenth day of June, A. D. 1862.

When to be published.

SECTION 3. Said list and notice shall be published in such newspaper in all respect as now provided by law; and any person shall be entitled to redeem any of such lands at any time within six months after the publication of the list and notice, as required by this act.

Redemption.

SECTION 4. All deeds and conveyances of any lands mentioned in the notice and list which shall be published, as required by the provisions of this act, and which shall not be redeemed within six months after the publication of such list and notice, shall be as valid and effectual as if said notice and list had been published within the time [required by] and agreeably to the general laws of this state.

Validity of deeds.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 283.

[Published April 12, 1862.]

AN ACT in relation to the return of delinquent lands in certain cases.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

Repealed.

SECTION 1. That sections twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen and nineteen, of chapter ninety-six of the private and local laws of 1859, and chapter seventy-four (74) of the general laws of 1861, are hereby repealed, and all acts and parts of acts repealed by section twelve (12) aforesaid, are hereby revived and enacted.

Revived.

Return of delinquent lands.

SEC. 2. The clerk and treasurer of the city of Beaver Dam shall, on or before the first day of April, 1862, make out and return to the county treasurer of Dodge co. [county] a list of all lands & lots upon which the taxes for the year 1861 have not been paid; and shall annually thereafter make out and return like lists, at the same time and [in the same] manner as town treasurers are by law required to do.

Deposit of records, &c., relating to sale of lands.

SEC. 3. On or before the first day of April, 1862, the clerk and treasurer of the city of Beaver Dam shall deposit with the clerk of the board of supervisors of the county of Dodge, all the records & papers in their respective offices, relating to the sale of lands for unpaid taxes.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
