AN ACT to legalize the official acts of Eri D. Wilcox, as justice of the peace in the town of Exeter, and county of Green.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That all the official acts of Eri D. Wil-Acts legalized. cox, as justice of the peace in the town of Exeter, and county of Green, in this state, prior to the passage of this act, or so far as the same are consistent with the general laws of this state, are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid for all purposes, as though the said Eri D. Wilcox had caused his official bond and oath of office to have been made and filed according to law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 299.

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of Abijah W. Foster, as justice of the peace in the town of Rockland, county of Brown.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That all the official acts of Abijah W. Acts legalized. Foster, as justice of the peace in the town of Rockland, and county of Brown, in this state, prior to the passage of this act, so far as the same are consistent with the general laws of this state, are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid for all purposes, as though the said Abijah W. Foster had caused his official bond and oath of office to have been made and filed according to law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
