

CHAPTER 341.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 321 of the general laws of 1862, entitled "an act to repeal chapter 437 of the private and local laws of 1856, entitled 'an act to incorporate the village of Weyauwega,'" and to revive said chapter 437 of the private and local laws of 1856.

CHAPTER 342.

[Published June 17, 1862.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 332 of the general laws of the year 1862, entitled "an act relating to the redemption of lands which were sold for unpaid taxes levied in the year 1858."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Validity of lists that may already have been published.

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter three hundred and thirty-two of the general laws of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-two, entitled "an act relating to the redemption of lands which were sold for unpaid taxes levied in the year 1858," is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words, to wit: "In all cases where, by the charter of any city, the city treasurer or other officer is authorized to sell the lands in such city for unpaid taxes, if such city treasurer or other proper officer has caused to be published, as required by law, a list of unredeemed lands in such city, which were sold in the year 1859 for unpaid taxes of the preceding year, no further publication of such list shall be necessary; and in all cases where such city treasurer or other proper officer has not caused such list to be published, he shall cause such list to be published in the manner hereinbefore provided for the publication of similar lists by the clerks of county boards of supervisors."

SECTION 2. This act shall be published and take effect immediately.
