maliciously place any obstruction or thing upon the track of said road, such person so offending shall each of them, for every such offense, forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding three times the amount of damages caused by such offense, which may be recovered in the name of said company, by action of debt in any court having competent jurisdiction in the county wherein the offense shall be committed, and shall also be subject to indictment, and upon conviction of such offense, shall be punished by imprisonment and fine, or either, at the discretion of the court.

Public act.

SECTION 18. This act is hereby declared to be a public act, and shall be favorably construed to effect the purposes hereby intended, and copies thereof printed by authority of the state, shall be received as evidence thereof in all cases; and this act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 352.

[Published June 18, 1862.]

AN ACT to authorize the village of Two Rivers, in the county of Manitowoc, to construct and maintain bridges across the East and West Twin rivers, within the corporate limits of said village.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority.

SECTION 1. The president and trustees of the village of Two Rivers, are authorized to construct and maintain bridges across the East and West Twin rivers at the following points, to wit: On Main street, across the East Twin river; at the foot of Jefferson street, across the West Twin river; on Washington street, across the West Twin river; on Monroe street, across the West Twin river.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
