

CHAPTER 367.

[Published June 23, 1862.]

AN ACT to change the time of holding terms of the circuit court in Marquette county, and in relation to special terms in the counties of Dodge, Green Lake and Washington, in the third judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

General terms.

SECTION 1. The general terms of the circuit court for the county of Marquette, shall hereafter be held on the fourth Monday of August and the fourth Monday in February, in each year.

Repeal of special term in Washington county, &c.

SECTION 2. So much of sections one and two of chapter eight of the general laws of 1860, as requires the judge to hold special terms of the circuit court in the county of Washington, in July of each year, and section two of chapter 106 of the general laws of 1860, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication, and repeal all acts inconsistent with this act.

CHAPTER 368.

[Published June 23, 1862.]

AN ACT relating to special terms of the circuit court in the sixth and fifth judicial circuit, [circuits,] and to change the time for holding the general terms in Marquette county, in the third judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Regular terms in Crawford, La Crosse, Monroe and Jackson counties.

SECTION 1. That the regular terms of the circuit court held in the counties of Crawford, La Crosse, Monroe and Jackson, in the sixth judicial circuit, shall be special terms for the whole of said circuit, for the purpose of hearing and determining all questions of law,

motions and demurrers, in the same manner and with the same force and effect as if the court were sitting in the county where such business originated.

SECTION 2. There shall be held in the county of La Crosse, in the said sixth circuit, by the judge thereof, on the second Tuesday of July, in each year hereafter, a special term of the said circuit court, for the purpose of hearing and determining questions of law, motions and demurrers from any county of the said circuit, with like force and effect as provided in section one of this act. Special term in La Crosse.

SECTION 3. There shall be held by the judge of the circuit court of the fifth judicial circuit, one special term of said court in the county of Iowa, for the hearing and trial of actions not requiring the intervention of a jury, for the trial of issues of law, for the hearing and determination of motions, and for transacting any and all other business that may be done at a regular term of said court, except the trial of issues of fact by a jury; said special term to commence on the fourth Monday in June, 1862, and of each and every year thereafter. SECTION 4. No notice of the holding of the special term provided for in the first section of this chapter, shall be required other than the passage and publication of this act. No other notice necessary

SECTION 5. Section 1 of chapter 172 of the general laws of 1862, is hereby amended by striking out [the word] "third" where it occurs in the third line of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fourth," so that it will read: "The general terms of the circuit court of the county of Marquette, shall hereafter be held on the fourth Monday in August and the fourth Monday in February, in each year." General terms in Marquette.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
