

CHAPTER 65.

AN ACT to amend chapter seven of the revised statutes, entitled "of general and special elections; of the manner of conducting the same, and of the canvass."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section ninety-nine of chapter seven of the revised statutes, entitled "of general and special elections; of the manner of conducting the same, and of the canvass," is hereby amended so as to read as follows, viz. : "The regular term of office of all state and county of ficers, when elected for a full term, shall commence on the first Monday of January next succeeding their election." When terms of office to commence.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 66.

AN ACT to amend chapter 190 of the general laws of 1859, entitled "an act to regulate insurance companies not incorporated by the state of Wisconsin," approved March 17, 1859.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and ninety of the general laws of 1859, entitled "an act to regulate insurance companies not incorporated by the state of Wisconsin," approved March 17th, 1859, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "Fifteenth. The act of incorporation of said company," as follows, viz. : "Sixteenth. The total number of policies issued during the year next preceding the making of the report, and the amount of risk thereon. Seventeenth. The number of policies cancelled [canceled] during the" Additional information to be embodied in statement.
