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CHAPTER 147.

[Published April 15, 1863.]

AN ACT to vacate certain additions to the city of La Crosse, and certain village plats in the county of La Crosse.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Additions vaca-

SECTION 1. The following additions to the city of La Crosse, in the county of La Crosse, are hereby vacated, viz.: Smith and Batchelder's addition, [and] all that portion of B. B. Healey's addition lying and being south of Tyler street, in said city of La Crosse.

Village plate vacated.

SECTION 2. The village plats of the village of South La Crosse, located and platted on the north-east quarter of the north-east quarter, and fractional lots one and seven, of section twenty-eight, in township fifteen, north of range seven west, [and] all that part of the village plat of the village of Neshonoc, lying east of the west line of Center street, north of the south line of Mill street, east of the west line of the alley in block seven, and south of the north line of Mentoria avenue, and north of the south line of Third street, west of the west line of Main street, are hereby vacated: provided, that any person or persons owning a lot or lots in either of the aforesaid additions, or in the plat of Neshonoc, or of South La Crosse, for the purposes of sale or paying taxes thereon, may describe such lot as heretofore, to wit: as lot -, of block -, in - addition, or in said village of Nechonoc, or South La Crosse.

Provise.

Section 3. This at shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
