

CHAPTER 220.

[Published April 18, 1868.]

AN ACT to provide for and prescribe the compensation to be paid by the several counties to their county treasurers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The several county treasurers of this state shall receive as compensation for their services, in lieu of all fees and emoluments now by law received by them for such services, a salary to be fixed and prescribed by the county board of supervisors of their respective counties, as hereinafter provided. Salaries to be fixed by county boards.

SECTION 2. At the annual meeting in November, 1863, the county boards of supervisors for the several counties in which county treasurers are to be elected in November, 1863, shall fix and determine the amount of the annual salary that the county treasurers of their respective counties shall receive ; and thereafter the salary of each county treasurer shall be fixed by the county board of supervisors, at its annual meeting after his election and before the commencement of his term of office ; and such salary shall not be increased or diminished during his said term of office. When to be fixed.

SECTION 3. The salary thus determined upon shall be paid out of the county treasury, out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated, and may be paid at the end of each and every quarter. How salaries payable.

SECTION 4. The fees now allowed by law to county treasurers shall be collected by them and paid into the treasury of the county, for the use of the county. Fees to be paid into treasuries.

SECTION 5. All acts and parts of acts conflicting with this act, are hereby repealed. Repeal.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
