state for expenses and disbursements authorized by any law of this state, and which by the laws of this state are payable out of the loan and the fund authorized and created by the act of which this is amendatory, denominated the war fund, shall be presented within two years from the time the same shall accrue; and all such claims and demands as are not presented for payment within two years from the time the same shall have accrued, shall be considered as donated to the state."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 267.

[Published April 23, 1863.]

AN ACT to remit to the City bank of Kenosha, located at Kenosha, in the state of Wisconsin, the sum of \$841 75.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby remitted to the City bank of Kenosha, located at Kenosha, in the state of Wisconsin, the sum of eight hundred and forty-one and 75-100 dollars, being balance of amount of bank tax unremitted, paid by said bank upon sixty-five thousand dollars of its capital stock into the state treasury, since the 30th day of June, A. D. 1862.

Appropriation.

SECTION 2. The state treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to said bank, on demand, the said sum of money mentioned in section one of this act; and there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, an amount sufficient for such purposes.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
