ance shall be valid and effectual to convey all the right, title and interest which was sold by such officer."

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 271.

[Published April 23, 1863.]

AN ACT to lay out a state road from Monroe, in Green county, to Gratoit, in La Fayette county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Commissioners.

SECTION 1. Charles S. Foster, A. G. Pinney and D. G. Tuttle are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a state road from Monroe, in Green county, through lot fifteen, section one, town one, range five east, crossing Spafford Branch near its mouth, to Gratoit, in La Fayette county.

Compensation,

SECTION 2. Any two of said commissioners may proceed to lay out and establish said road, and upon the performance of such service, shall be entitled to receive a reasonable compensation therefor from the counties through which said road may pass: provided, that no part of said expense shall be paid out of the state treasury.

SECTION 3. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
