## CHAPTER 321.

[Published April 28, 1863.]

AN ACT to authorize and empower M. Smith to build and maintain a dock and pier extending into Green Bay.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority to build dock. SECTION 1. M. Smith, his associates, successors, executors, heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to build and maintain a dock and pier extending into Green Bay, from the land owned by the said M. Smith, in the north-east quarter of the south-east quarter of section twenty-six, town twenty-seven, range twenty-three, in the town of Brussels, Door county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
