

## CHAPTER 4.

[Published February 7, 1863.]

AN ACT to change the time of holding the terms of the circuit court for Rock county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The terms of the circuit court for Rock county, shall hereafter be held at the following times :  
 1. A special law term on the second Monday in February, in each year hereafter ; but no term shall be held under the provisions of this act on the second Monday of February, 1863. 2. A general term of said court shall be held on the third Monday of May, and on the first Monday of December, in each year.

SECTION 2. All writs, process and recognizances returnable at the June term of said court, are hereby made returnable to the term hereby required to be held on the third Monday of May ; and all writs, process and recognizances returnable at the November term of said court, as now fixed by law, are hereby made returnable to the December term, as fixed by this act. Said May and December terms shall be jury terms.

SECTION 3. This act shall be published immediately, and shall be in force from and after its publication.

## CHAPTER 5.

[Published February 13, 1863.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the city of Beloit.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of taxes in the city of Beloit, in the county of Rock, is hereby extended till the first Monday of April, 1863 : *provided,*

that this act shall not be so construed as to extend the time for the payment of state taxes.

Authority to  
treasurer—his  
return.

SECTION 2. The treasurer of said city shall have the same power and authority to collect the taxes contained in said city tax-roll, after as before such extension of time for the collection of said taxes; and the return of the city treasurer to the county treasurer, within the time limited for the collection of taxes by this act, shall be as valid as if made pursuant to the direction of the original warrant.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 6.

[Published February 13, 1863.]

AN ACT to provide for the disbursement of moneys levied and collected by the board of supervisors of Milwaukee county, for supporting families of volunteers.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

To be disbursed  
by county board  
of supervisors.

SECTION 1. The county board of supervisors of Milwaukee county, shall have power to provide for the support of families of drafted persons, out of the moneys which have been levied and collected by said county board, or may hereafter be levied and collected for the support of families of volunteers, in the same manner as said board now is authorized to disburse said moneys so collected for providing for supporting families of volunteers in the military service of the United States or of this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
