

## CHAPTER 50.

[Published March 17, 1863.]

AN ACT relative to the publication of lands sold for taxes in certain cases.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Publication of lands omitted in clerks' lists.

SECTION 1. Whenever by mistake, omission or otherwise, the clerk of the county board of supervisors of any county of this state, shall neglect or fail to include in his list, any tract or tracts of land, as required by section 16 of chapter 22 of the session laws of 1859, the same may be published at any time within one year after the three years mentioned in said act shall have expired: said publication to be made in the same manner and for the same period of time as in said section required; and all deeds of lands made in pursuance thereof, shall be as valid and effectual as if the publication had been made in the manner required by said act.

Validity of deeds issued thereon.

Publication of omitted lands for taxes of 1858.

SECTION 2. All or any tracts of land sold in the year 1859, for taxes of 1858, which may have been omitted to be advertised for conveyance, in consequence of any error, mistake or misdescription thereof made by the clerk of the board of supervisors, may be published for the length of time required by said act, at any time within one year from the date of the passage of this act; and all deeds made in pursuance thereof, shall be as valid and effectual as if made in accordance with said section sixteen.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
