Duty of clerk of ing the votes east for county judge in his county; and after receiving such statement, the said clerk shall proceed to constitute a board of county canvassers, and said board of canvassers shall proceed to determine the person elected county judge, in the same manner as is provided in section thirteen of the act of which this [is] amendatory.

CHAPTER 61.

AN ACT for the relief of the Sheboygan county agricultural society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

When order may be issued in favor of. Section 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order upon the state treasurer, in favor of the Sheboygan county agricultural society, pursuant to section five of chapter fifty-three of the general laws of 1858, in the same manner as though the annual report of said society had been received and filed previously to the first day of February, 1863.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
