

criminal, that may be done and transacted at a regular term of said court, except the trial of issues of fact by a jury.

No other notice required.

SECTION 2. No notice of the holding of the special term or terms of court provided for in the first section of this act, shall be required other than the passage and publication of this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 83.

[Published March 25, 1863.]

AN ACT to authorize the towns, cities and villages in the county of Dodge, to raise money for the payment of bounties to volunteers.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

Authority to towns, cities and villages to refund bounties paid to volunteers.

SECTION 1. The qualified electors of each town, city or incorporated village in the county of Dodge, shall have power, at any annual town meeting thereof, to vote to raise such sum or sums of money as they may deem necessary, for the payment of bounties to volunteers, residents of such town, city or incorporated village, mustered into the military service of the United States or of this state, and to refund to any person or persons who may have paid bounties to volunteers, such sum or sums of money [as] the town board of supervisors shall ascertain has been so paid: *provided*, that no greater sum of money shall be voted or raised than has been paid to said volunteers.

Proviso.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
