

CHAPTER 185.

[Published March 17, 1864.]

AN ACT to legalize the acts of certain town meetings held in the town of Argyle, in the county of La Fayette, at which bounties were voted to persons who may enter or may have entered the military service of the United States, to the credit of said town.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The proceedings of two special town meetings of the town of Argyle, in the county of La Fayette, at which a bounty was voted to persons who may enter or may have entered the military service of the United States, to the credit of said town, the first held on the 5th day of January, 1864, the second held on 16th day of February, 1864, and the taxes voted to be levied and collected in pursuance thereof, are hereby made and declared to be legal and valid to all intents and purposes, notwithstanding any errors and omissions in calling or conducting either of said meetings, or in levying said tax. Meetings and bounty tax legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 186.

[Published March 17, 1864.]

AN ACT to authorize the town of Taycheedah, in the county of Fond du Lac, to issue orders upon the treasurer of said town in accordance with a vote of said town.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The chairman of the town of Taycheedah, in the county of Fond du Lac, and the clerk of the said town, shall issue and respectively sign and countersign orders drawing interest at the rate of seven per centum per annum, in accordance with a vote of said town, to an amount not exceeding two thousand Orders may be issued to pay bounties to volunteers.
