

CHAPTER 415.

[Published April 28, 1864.]

AN ACT to vacate a part of Capron's addition to the city of Berlin.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. All that part of Capron's addition to the city of Berlin, in the county of Green Lake, lying between Cumberland street and Seward street, and Jackson street and Kossuth street, *(be and the same)* is hereby vacated: *provided, however,* that such vacation shall not in anywise affect or impair any assessment thereof heretofore made, nor any tax heretofore levied thereon, or levied on any lot, tract or parcel thereof. Vacated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 416.

AN ACT to legalize the proceedings of a special town meeting held in the town of Union, Rock county, for the purpose of voting a tax to pay bounties to volunteers.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. All the proceedings of a special town meeting held on the twenty-third day of December, in the town of Union, in the county of Rock, for the purpose of voting a tax to pay bounties to volunteers, are hereby declared valid and legal. Legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
