GENERAL LAWS-CH. 90, 91.

CHAPTER 90.

[Published March 2, 1864.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 14 of the revised statutes, entitled "of resignations, vacancies and removals, and of supplying vacancies."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Resignation of judges—to whom made. SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended, by adding thereto, to stand as subdivision six, the following: "By the judges of the supreme, circuit or county courts, to the governor."

SECTION 2. Section 13 of said chapter is also hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "Sec. 13. When at any time there shall be in either of the offices of county judge, register of deeds, district attorney, sheriff or coroner, no officer duly authorized to execute the duties thereof, some suitable person may be appointed by the governor to fill such vacancy."

SECTION 3. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 91.

[Published March 2, 1864.]

AN ACT to incorporate the village of Boscobel.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Village of Boscobel-boundaries.

SECTION 1. All of that district of country described as follows: All of section twenty-two which lies in Grant county, the west half of section twenty-six, all of the east half of section twenty-seven which lies in Grant county, the northeast quarter of section thirty-four, and the northwest quarter of section thirty-five, all in town eight north, of range three west, shall hereafter be known and designated by the name of the "village of Boscobel," and the inhabitants residing or who may here-
