# CHAPTER 180.

#### [Published Marsh 28, 1865.]

AN ACT to amend section nine of chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes, entitled "of the state superintendent of public property, and the purchase and distribution of stationery for the use of the state."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes, entitled " of the state superintendent of public property, and the purchase and distribution of stationery for the use of the state," is hereby amended, by inserting after " to the clerk of the supreme court, for the supreme court room," in said ninth section, the words, "to the secretary of the state historical society, for the state historical society room and correspondence."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred and twenty-seven of the general laws of 1864, relating to the county court of Fend du Lac county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and twenty-seven (127) of the general laws of 1864, relating to the county court of Fond du Lac county, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. All suits and proceedings now pending in said county court, under and by virtue of the provisions of chapter one hundred and twenty-seven (127,) general laws 1864, are hereby transferred to the circuit court of Fond du Lac county, and the same shall be

tried and determined in said circuit court in the same manner as though originally commenced therein.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 132.

[Published March 28, 1865.]

AN ACT relating to the adoption of children, and amendatory of section one of chapter two hundred and seventy-eight of the laws of 1864.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and By whom con seventy-eight of the laws of 1864, is hereby amended, may be given. so as to read as follows : "Section two of chapter fortynine of the revised statutes is hereby amended, so as to read as follows : 'Section 2. No such adoption shall be made without the consent, in writing, of such of the parents of said child as may be living, unless it shall appear to the judge that either of the parents has abandoned the child, or gone to parts unknown, when such consent may be given by the parent, if any, having the charge and care of the child. And in case where neither of the parents is living, or if the only living parent has abandoned the child, such consent may be given by the guardian, if such child has any, and if there be no guardian, such consent may then be given by any of the next of kin of such child, residing in this state; and if there be no such next of kin, or if such next of kin is unknown, such consent may be given by some suitable person to be appointed by such judge; and in case of a child not born in lawful wedlock, such consent may be given by the mother : provided, she is living and has not aban loned such child."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
