

CHAPTER 356.

[Published May 24, 1865.]

AN ACT for the relief of the Polk county agricultural society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order upon the state treasurer in favor of the Polk county agricultural society, pursuant to section five of chapter fifty-three of the general laws of 1858, in the same manner as though the annual report of said society had been received on the first day of February, 1865: *provided*, said report be on file in the office of the secretary of state at the time of the passage of this act.

When order may be issued in favor of.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 357.

[Published May 24, 1865.]

AN ACT to amend the charter of the city of Oshkosh.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That whenever hereafter any taxes are levied by the common council of the city of Oshkosh, the same may be extended in the aggregate in one column.

Taxes aggregated.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of the city treasurer of said city, to give receipts for taxes collected by him, in which shall be shown the amount of assessment on which the tax is collected, and also the per centage levied by said council for each specific purpose.

Receipt for taxes

SECTION 3. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

Repeal

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
