## CHAPTER 532.

[Published May 9, 1865.]

AN ACT relative to county treasurers and clerks of the county boards of supervisors.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Account and pay  
ment into treasury  
of fees of  
county treasurers  
and clerks of  
boards.

SECTION 1. It is hereby made the duty of the several county treasurers and clerks of the county boards of supervisors, to keep full and accurate accounts of all fees received by them, respectively, and make report thereon, verified on oath, to the county board of supervisors of their respective counties, at each annual session thereof, and on the first day of each month they shall pay the whole amount of fees then in their hands into the county treasury, for the use of the county.

Fees on delin-  
quent lands.

SECTION 2. It is hereby made the duty of the county treasurer to account for the five per cent. collection fees on delinquent lands, as the assets of the county, except when by special act he is directed to pay it over

to towns or town officers; and he shall in no case be allowed to retain such fees for his own use.

SECTION 3. If any treasurer or clerk as aforesaid, Penalty. shall violate any of the provisions of this act, he shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars, and shall be liable to the county in an action of debt for double the amount of fees unlawfully retained by him.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect when published.

CHAPTER 533.

[Published June 6, 1865.]

AN ACT to accept the grant of lands made to the state of Wisconsin, by act of congress approved June 25th, 1864, to aid in the construction of a military road from Wausau, Marathon county, to Lake Superior.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The grant of lands accruing to the state Grant accepted. of Wisconsin, under and by virtue of an act of congress granting lands to the state of Wisconsin, approved June 25th, 1864, to aid in the construction of a military wagon road from Wausau, in the county of Marathon, following the Wisconsin river as far as Skouowany, and from thence on the most feasible and direct route to a point on the state line between the states of Wisconsin and Michigan, in a direction leading to Ontonagon, on Lake Superior, *(be and the same)* is hereby accepted, in accordance with the conditions and provisions of said act.

SECTION 2. The governor of the state of Wisconsin Commissioners to lay out road. is hereby authorized and required to appoint three agents or commissioners to survey, locate and construct said road, as is provided in section four of said act.
