

CHAPTER 78.

[Published March 4, 1865.]

AN ACT to authorize the collection of a bounty tax in the town of Emmet, Dodge county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The town board of supervisors of the town of Emmet, in Dodge county, are hereby authorized to apportion upon the assessment roll of said town for the year 1864, the sum voted by the electors of said town, on the 16th day of February, A. D. 1865, for the payment of bounties; and the tax so apportioned shall be collected and all proceedings incident thereto shall be had in the same manner and with the like effect as if said meeting had been held prior to the 15th day of February, A. D. 1865.

Bounty tax authorized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect when published.

CHAPTER 79.

[Published March 8, 1865.]

AN ACT to detach a portion of the town of Roxbury, Dane county, and attach the same to the town of Mazomanie, in the same county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. All that portion of township number nine (9) north, of range number six (6) east, being fractional sections numbers thirteen (13,) twenty-four (24,) and sections numbers twenty-five (25,) thirty-five (35) and thirty-six (36) of said township, is hereby detached from the town of Roxbury, Dane county, and attached to and made a part of the town of Mazomanie, Dane county, for all purposes whatsoever: *provided*, that all taxes voted by said town of Roxbury for
