

CHAPTER 8.

[Published February 8, 1865.]

AN ACT to legalize the tax roll of the town of La Grange, in the county of Walworth, for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The tax roll of the town of La Grange, Tax roll legalized in the county of Walworth, for the year 1864, as made by the town clerk of said town, including all corrections made by said clerk after said tax roll was placed in the hands of the treasurer of said town, is hereby legalized and declared valid for all purposes whatsoever, notwithstanding the law may not have been fully complied with in all respects in making out and delivering the said tax roll to the treasurer of said town.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 9.

[Published January 30, 1865.]

AN ACT to legalize certain acts of the officers of the towns of Buena Vista and Richland, in the county of Richland.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All the acts and proceedings of the Bounty tax proceedings legalized. town officers of the towns of Buena Vista and Richland, in the county of Richland, in authorizing and proceeding to the immediate collection of a special tax authorized by a vote of the electors of each of said towns, for the purpose of procuring volunteers to be credited to said towns under the last call of the president of the United States for three hundred thousand men, at special town meetings called for that purpose, and held in the town of Buena Vista on the thirty-first

day of December, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, and in the said town of Richland on the second day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, are hereby declared valid and legal for all purposes whatsoever.

Sale of lands for delinquent taxes.

SECTION 2. The county treasurer of the said county of Richland is hereby authorized and empowered to sell any lands upon which said special tax shall not be paid, when returned to his office, at the same time and in the same manner as is now provided by law for the sale of lands for the non-payment of taxes.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 10.

[Published January 30, 1865.]

AN ACT to legalize the acts of the supervisors of the town of Otsego, in the county of Columbia.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Acts of supervisors legalized.

SECTION 1. The acts of the supervisors of the town of Otsego, in the county of Columbia, in applying the sum of two hundred and seventeen dollars towards the bounty to volunteers, are hereby legalized and declared to be valid.

Orders may issue.

SECTION 2. The supervisors of said town are hereby authorized to issue orders amounting to two hundred and seventeen dollars and interest, to pay said indebtedness; said amount of money to be added to the next tax roll of the town, and collected as other money.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
