CHAPTER 108.

[Published April 28, 1866.]

AN ACT to authorize town and school district boards to audit the amount of subscription for "Moser's town and school officers'

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority.

SECTION 1. The town board of any town and the district board of any school district in this state, may audit to the several officers of their town or school district, respectively, the amount of subscription paid for "Moser's Wisconsin town and school officers' manual."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 109.

[Published April 24, 1866.]

AN ACT to amend section 9 of chap. 261 of the general laws of 1864, entitled "an act to provide for realizing the amount of unpaid mortgages due to the state."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter two hundred If land shall be had not a sum and sixty-one of the general laws of 1864, is hereby less than that amended, so as to read as follows: "Section four of instituted for balance. chapter one hundred and thirty of the general laws of 1858, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: 'When any land or other property mortgaged to the state, shall have been sold upon foreclosure of such mortgage, or shall have been bid in for the state, at a sale made by the commissioners, for a sum insufficient to pay the principal and interest so secured, with the proper costs and disbursements, the commissioners are hereby required to take proper steps to collect the remainder due from the person who may be personally responsible for the payment of the same; and for that
