

CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and thirty-four of the revised statutes, entitled "of executions and proceedings supplementary thereto."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, r. presented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

SECTION 1. The seventh clause of section thirty-one of chapter one hundred and thirty-four of the revised statutes, "of executions and proceedings supplementary thereto," is hereby amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: 7. Two cows, ten swine, one yoke of oxen and one horse or mule, or in lieu of one yoke of oxen and a horse or mule, a span of horses or a span of mules, ten sheep and the wool from the same, either in the raw material or manufactured into yarn or cloth; the necessary food for all of the stock mentioned in this section for one year's support, either provided or growing, or both, as the debtor may choose; also one wagon, cart or dray, one sleigh, one plough, one drag, and other farming utensils, including tackle for teams, not exceeding fifty dollars in value.

Construction of act.

SECTION 2. This act shall not be construed to amend or repeal chapter 11 of the general laws passed and enacted in the year 1862, entitled "an act to amend section 31 of chapter 134 of the revised statutes, entitled 'of executions and proceedings supplementary thereto.'"

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
