

CHAPTER 127.

[Published March 24, 1870.]

AN ACT to fix the time of holding the January term of the circuit court for Brown county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Term fixed.

SECTION 1. The January term of the circuit court in and for the county of Brown, Wisconsin, shall commence on the third Monday of January in each year, instead of the second Monday in January, as now provided by law.

Repealed.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed so far as they affect the provisions of this act, and no further.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 128.

[Published March 24, 1870.]

AN ACT to require cities to make their annual school reports direct to the state superintendent of public instruction.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Shall make annual report.

SECTION 1. Each city of this state which is not under the jurisdiction of a county superintendent, in the matter of supervision of schools and examination of teachers, shall hereafter make the annual report required by sections 43, 57 and 139 of chapter 155 of the general laws of 1868, direct to the state superintendent of public instruction, instead of to the county superintendent.
