## CHAPTER 29.

[Published February 27, 1871]

AN ACT to authorize the judge of the eighth judicial circuit court for the state of Wisconsin to appoint a court commissioner in the county of Chippewa, in addition to those now authorized by law.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That the circuit judge of the eighth May appoint judicial circuit for the state of Wisconsin, is hereby court commisauthorized and empowered to appoint one court commissioner in and for the county of Chippewa in said circuit, in addition to the number now authorized to be appointed by law.

SECTION 2. That the person appointed such court Powers and commissioner under this act shall have all the power commissioner. and authority conferred by, and be subject to all the requirements under the laws relating to court commissioners in this state, and shall hold his office for the . term of two years from the time of his appointment.
