AN ACT to amend section two of chapter 144 of the general laws of 1870, entitled "an act to amend section four of chapter 180 of the general laws of 1868, entitled an act to provide for the assessment of property for taxation, and the levy of taxes thereon."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter 144 of the gen-Amended. eral laws of 1870 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 2. The secretary of state shall state to apport apportion the state tax levied for the year among the several counties, and shall carry out opposite to the name of each county on the list aforesaid, the amount of state tax apportioned thereto, according and in proportion to the relative valuation of each county to the aggregate valuation of the whole state, and shall thereupon, on or before the second Monday of October in each year, certify to the clerk of the board of supervisors of each county, the amount of state tax so apportioned to and levied upon his county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
