## CHAPTER 99.

## [Published March 22, 1871.]

AN ACT to further provide for the completion of the Northern Hospital for the Insane at Oshkosh.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 39 of the general Amended. laws of 1870 is hereby amended by adding to the end of said section as follows: "and also by the appropriation made in section 4 of chapter 39 of the general laws of 1871, entitled an act to prepare the additional institution for the insane, at Oshkosh, for the reception of patients," passed in session of 1871.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 100.

[Published March 22, 1871.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 824, general laws of 1864, entitled an act to aid the Tomah and Lake St. Croix Railroad Company.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter 324 of the Amended general laws of 1864, entitled an act to aid the Tomah and Lake St. Croix Railroad Company, be and the same is hereby amended by adding to said section the words, "excepting the lands situated in the county of Pierce."

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of abts inconsistent with or in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
