ive weeks in some newspaper published at the county seat of said county before such special term, and a jury may be selected for any such called special term in the same manner as for general terms of said court, when in the discretion of said judge it is deemed necessary. A special term of said court shall be held on the first Monday of each month, except the months of February, May, July, August and October: provided, that no issues of fact nor appeals from justices' courts shall be tried or heard at such special terms. Such special terms may be held at the office of the county judge of said county, and no officer shall receive any compensation for attendance upon such special terms, unless directed to attend by the judge of said court.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 21.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named for the payment of current expenses at the Institution for the Education of the Blind, for the year 1872.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Appropriated.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twenty-one thousand dollars in full, for the payment of current expenses at the Institution for the Education of the Blind, for the year 1872.

SECTION 2. All sums for current expenses shall be drawn from the treasury not oftener than quarterly in advance.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication, and shall be printed in the volume of general laws for the year 1872.
