

CHAPTER 31.

[Published March 8, 1872.]

AN ACT to provide for the purchase of four hundred copies of Webster's Dictionary, unabridged.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The state superintendent of public instruction is hereby authorized and directed to purchase, on behalf of the state, four hundred copies of the latest edition of Webster's Unabridged Dictionary, at a cost not to exceed eight dollars per copy. Shall purchase dictionaries.

SECTION 2. The said dictionaries, when procured, shall be distributed in accordance with the provisions of chapters sixteen and thirty-two of the general laws of 1867. How to be distributed.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the income of the school fund, a sum sufficient to pay for the dictionaries above provided for. Appropriated.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 32.

[Published April 3, 1872.]

AN ACT making election days legal holidays.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The day of holding the general election in each year shall be a legal holiday. A legal holiday.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
