treasurer of such town; which statement shall specify the date of each payment, the amount of such payment, and the account upon which such payment is made,

SECTION 2. The town clerks of the several towns shall furnish in this state shall, at the time a settlement is required statement to town board. by law to be made with the town treasurers, furnish to the town board, for their reference, the statement required to be made by section one of this act.

SECTION 3. It shall not be lawful for any county when unlawful treasurer to pay to the treasurer of any town, any money money. in his hands belonging to such town, from the third Monday of March until ten days after the annual town meeting of the same year, except upon the written order of the board of supervisors of such town.

Section 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 44.

[Published April 8, 1872.]

AN ACT to regulate the price for license to persons dealing in spirituous or intoxicating liquors in the several towns and incorporated villages in this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The price for license to each person Price of license dealing in spirituous or intoxicating liquors in the several towns and incorporated villages and cities in this state, shall not be less than twenty-five dollars or exceed one hundred dollars.

Section 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
