

CHAPTER 172.

[Published March 25, 1873.]

AN ACT refunding to the county judge of Buffalo county a certain amount therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

State treasurer
to refund.

SECTION 1. The state treasurer is hereby directed to refund to the county judge of Buffalo county, the sum of fifty-six dollars and thirty-five cents, being the amount paid into the state treasury by the said county judge, February 28, 1868, on account of the sale of the effects of Isaac Carr, deceased: *provided*, that the secretary of state is furnished with evidence of the fact that legal heirship has been established to the estate of the said Isaac Carr.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 173.

[Published March 21, 1873.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter four hundred and sixty-six, private and local laws of 1871, amendatory of the charter of the village of Elkhorn.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Repealed.

SECTION 1. Chapter four hundred and sixty-six of the private and local laws of 1871, entitled "an act to amend an act to amend chapter one hundred and thirty-three of the private and local laws of 1868, entitled 'an act to amend an act, entitled an act to incorporate the village of Elkhorn,'" is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
