CHAPTER 37.

[*Published February 21, 1873.*]

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and forty of the private and local laws of 1872, entitled "an act to amend chapter four hundred and seventy-four of the private and local laws of 1866, entitled 'an act to reduce the act incorporating the city of Janesville and the several acts amendatory thereof, into one act, and amend the same.' "

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section four of chapter one hundred ^{Amended.} and forty of the private and local laws of 1872, entitled 'an act to amend chapter four hundred and seventy-four of the private and local laws of 1866, entitled "an act to reduce the act incorporating the city of Janesville, and the several acts amendatory thereof, into one act, and amend the same,"' is hereby amended by striking out of said section the following words, to wit: Section seventeen of chapter four of said act is hereby amended by adding thereto as follows: "one-half of all moneys paid into the treasury of said city, for licenses for vending and dealing in spirituous, vinous and fermented liquors, shall be paid by the city treasurer, immediately after the receipt thereof by him, to the treasurer of the Young Men's Association of the city of Janesville, to be used by such association in the purchase of books for its library."

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with or in any manner contravening the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
