## CHAPTER 49.

[Published February 26, 1878.]

AN ACT to amend chapter four hundred and nineteen of the general laws of 1864, entitled "an act to prevent the establishment of cemeteries and burial grounds within the limits of cities and villages."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended regulating establishment of cemeteris. SECTION 1. Chapter four hundred and nineteen of the general laws of 1864 is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the word, "erected," and before the word, "and," in the 12th line thereof, a clause as follows, viz: "or to lay out or establish any such cemetery or burial grounds outside the limits of the recorded plat of any such city or village, or addition thereto, and within two hundred rods of any inhabited dwelling standing on any lot or block in such city, village or addition, without first obtaining the consent of the municipal authorities of such city or village thereto."

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 50.

[Published February 23, 1873.]

AN ACT to extend the use of the state library.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Shall lend books. SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the state librarian to lend for use in the courts of the United States sitting at the capital, any book or books in the state library, upon the written request of the judge of the district court of the United States for the western district of Wisconsin, such judges assuming the safe return to the library of any such book or books so loaned.
