CHAPTER 109.

AN ACT to provide for the proper safe keeping of the report ot the geological survey.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the secretary of Report of state to cause the manuscript of the report of the geo-vey to be bound logical survey recently submitted to the governor to be and indexed. bound in convenient form for reference, and in such manner as to be liable to the least possible injury when in use, and the maps and drawings shall be bound in like manner and in proper order, and a suitable index shall be made to the maps and drawings thus bound.

SECTION 2. When thus bound the report shall be Shall be deposisubject to examination by any person wishing to do so, tary of state. but it shall not be taken from the office of the secretary of state, and when not in use it shall be kept in the vaults of the office, secure from destruction by fire: provided, that the chief geologist shall, at any time, have access to the same for the purpose of correction thereof.

This act shall be in force from and after SECTION 3. its passage.

CHAPTER 110.

AN ACT relating to telegraph companies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Any telegraph company that has been way borrow or hereafter may be organized under and by virtue of money. any law in this state, and doing business therein, is hereby authorized and empowered, acting by its board of directors, to borrow any sum or sums of money from any person or persons, corporation or body politic
