

CHAPTER 251.

[Published March 24, 1874.]

AN ACT to provide for the publication of notices in judicial proceedings in certain cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Notice how published.

SECTION 1. Whenever a notice shall be required to be published in a newspaper in any judicial proceeding pending in any county in this state where but one newspaper is published, and it shall be made to appear satisfactorily to the court or judge or court commissioner of such court, that the publisher of such newspaper refuses to publish such notice, such court judge or court commissioner may direct and order such notice to be published in a newspaper printed and published in an adjoining county, if a newspaper be published in said adjoining county ; if not, then in a newspaper published at the capital of the state of Wisconsin, and the publication made in pursuance of such order or direction, shall have the same effect and be as valid as though published in the county where said proceedings are pending ; and in all such cases said court judge or court commissioner shall also order that a written or printed copy of said notice shall be posted in at least three of the most public places in the county where said judicial proceedings are pending.

Where may be published.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
