

CHAPTER 285.

[Published March 26, 1874.]

AN ACT in relation to railroad companies organized under and by virtue of chapter 73 of the revised statutes, entitled "of joint stock companies."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Any and every corporation heretofore organized for railroad purposes under the provisions of chapter 73 of the revised statutes of 1858, entitled "of joint stock companies," shall have and possess every power and privilege conferred and be subject to all the duties and liabilities provided by chapter 119 of the general laws of 1872, entitled "an act in relation to railroads and the organization of railroad companies, and the acts supplementary thereto," upon companies organized under said chapter 119 and other acts supplementary thereto.

Powers and duties of railroad companies organized under provision of ch. 73, of revised statutes of 1858.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 286.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and thirty-seven of the general laws of 1871, entitled "an act to provide for the trial of offenses upon information, and to make the general laws of the state applicable thereto."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision two of section forty-three of chapter one hundred and thirty-seven of the general laws of 1871, entitled "an act to provide for the trial of offenses upon information, and to make the general laws of the state applicable thereto," is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 2. An indictment or information for crime punishable by imprisonment for life, may be found or filed at any period. All indictments or informations for other crimes, except misde-
