

CHAPTER 137.

[Published March 8, 1875.]

AN ACT to amend section five (5), of chapter one hundred and forty (140), of private and local laws of 1872, entitled, "An act to amend chapter four hundred and seventy-four (474), of the private and local laws of 1866, entitled, 'An act to reduce the act incorporating the city of Janesville, and the several acts amendatory thereof into one act, and amend the same.'"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended. SECTION 1. Section five (5), of chapter one hundred and forty (140), of private and local laws of 1872, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "Subdivision five (5), of section one (1), of chapter five (5), of said act as amended, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Second. To annually levy and collect such amount as the board of education shall have determined and certified in their opinion to be necessary or proper to be raised under this subdivision, not exceeding the amount of fifteen thousand dollars, on all real and personal property in said city, to meet the expenses of repairing school houses, and of supporting and maintaining schools, which shall constitute a part of the school fund."

Levy and collection of school tax.

Repealed. SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
