

insurance company in this state, and any and every such service shall be deemed a valid personal service upon any such insurance company.

Definition of term "agent."

SECTION 2. The term agent or agents used in the foregoing section shall include an agent, surveyor, broker or any person who shall receive any application or make any contract for insurance, or collect or receive any premium or deliver any policy.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 206.

AN ACT relative to the disposition and expenditure of license money in the village of Young America, in the town of Barton, county of Washington.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

License money to be expended on sidewalks.

SECTION 1. All moneys derived since the first day of April, A. D. 1874, or hereafter to be derived from licensing the sale of strong, spirituous, ardent or intoxicating liquors, in the village of Young America, in the town of Barton, and county of Washington, shall be applied and expended under the direction of the town board of supervisors of said town, in the making and building and construction of side-walks in said village of Young America, in said town of Barton.

SECTION 2. This act is hereby declared to be a public act, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
