## CHAPTER 219.

[Published March 11, 1875.]

AN ACT to prevent the hunting of deer with dogs in the county of Kewaunee.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall not be lawful for any person or Unlawful to ebase deer with persons to hunt, chase, drive, worry or kill, with dogs, any wild buck, doe or fawn, in the county of Kewaunee, at any time, and any person or persons offending against the provisions of this section shall Penalty for be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars violation.

and not more than twenty-five dollars for each and every offense, together with costs of suit, and shall be imprisoned in the county jail of the proper county until said fine and costs are fully paid, or are discharged according to law.

Justice of the SECTION 2. Justices of the peace shall have juris-peace to have diction to hear, try and determine all cases which SECTION 2. Justices of the peace shall have jurismay arise under the provisions of this chapter; provided, that the defendant shall not be deprived of a jury trial, nor of his rights of appeal as in other Cases.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved March 4, 1875.

SECTION 1. The name of the Lutheran Trinity Change of name Church, in the town of Oak Grove, county of Pierce, is hereby changed to Evangelical St. John's Church.
