

## CHAPTER 241.

[Published March 15, 1875.]

**AN ACT** authorizing the Governor to procure maps, plats, and lists of the lands granted to the state of Wisconsin, to aid in the construction of railroads, by the acts of Congress approved June 3, 1856, and May 5, 1864.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Governor to procure maps, plats and lists of lands granted to state by congress. SECTION 1. The Governor is hereby authorized and directed to procure from the United States such full and complete maps, plats and lists of the lands granted to the state of Wisconsin to aid in the construction of railroads, by acts of Congress approved June 3, 1856, and May 5, 1864, as will show what sections and parts of sections have been reserved from sale by the general government under said acts, to be approved to the state for the purpose aforesaid.

Appropriation so defray expenses. SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the fund derived from trespass on said lands, a sufficient sum, not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00), to pay all expenses incurred under this act; and the secretary of state is hereby directed to draw his warrant on said fund for the amount of said expenses upon the presentation to him of an itemized account thereof, approved by the Governor.

SECTION 3. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 242.

[Published March 15, 1875.]

**AN ACT** to establish lumber-district number eleven (11) in the state of Wisconsin.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Organization of lumber district No. 11. SECTION 1. For the purpose of inspecting and regulating the survey and measurement of logs, timber and lumber in this state, the counties of Ashland
