## CHAPTER 305.

## [Published March 25, 1875.]

AN ACT to re-enact chapter 533 of the general laws of 1865, entitled "An act to accept the grant of lands made to the state of Wisconsin by act of Congress approved June 25th, 1864, to aid in the construction of a military road from Wausau to Lake Superior."

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Preamble.

Re-enacted.

SECTION 1. Whereas, it has been established by the decisions of the United States Courts, that the title to lands granted by Congress to the state of Wisconsin, for specific purposes of improvement, remains in the state subject to its disposition for the specific purposes designated by such grants, notwithstanding the time for the completion of such improvements has expired; now therefore, chapter five hundred and thirty-three (533) of the general laws of this state for the year 1865, approved April 10, 1865, and cntitled "an act to accept the grant of lands made to the state of Wisconsin, by act of Congress approved June 25th, 1864, to aid in the construction of a military road from Wausau, Marathon county, to Lake Superior," is hereby re-enacted and declared to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
