

CHAPTER 161.

[Published March 15, 1876.]

AN ACT authorizing the city of Watertown, by its board of street commissioners, to purchase a steam fire engine and necessary equipments, at an expense of not more than eight thousand dollars (\$8,000).

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The board of street commissioners of the city of Watertown is hereby authorized to purchase a steam fire engine and the necessary equipments therefor, at a cost of not more than eight thousand dollars (\$8,000).

Authority to purchase fire engine.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 162.

[Published March 15, 1876.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of supervisors of Chippewa county, to fix the salary of county superintendent of schools.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The board of supervisors of Chippewa county, at any annual or adjourned meeting, are hereby authorized and empowered to fix and determine the salary to be paid to the county superintendent of schools of said county, for the term of office to which he is now elected, in such sum as in their judgment is just and equitable, not exceeding the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

Salary of county superintendent.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
